 - I was able to attend via Zoom as TVARC tested a simpler implementation of the conferencing tool.
 - There were a couple of wrinkles in the process, but overall the trial was a success.
 - We will try again this meeting with some enhancements.
- The Monday evening TVARC Ragchew Net has four new Net Control Stations. AD4MO, KG4WJI, N4GL and NP2B will rotate week by week under the overall coordination of N4GL. THANK YOU ALL!
- Next month we will begin to plan for Radio On The Square in November.

- TVARC is going digital! The board voted to purchase a Yaesu System Fusion repeater to replace our 443.150 repeater.
- Our 443.150 repeater is 30-some years old and is getting difficult to repair (even for K4LFK!)
- The new repeater, model DR-2X cost \$700. It normally sells for \$1,700, but we got it on sale.



- The Yaesu DR-2X is a digital/conventional FM dual-mode repeater.
- It covers VHF (2M) and UHF (440MHz).
- It can automatically detect whether you are using conventional FM or 12.5 kHz C4FM digital.
 - We don't all have to rush out and buy new digital radios. Our existing FM radios will still work.
- Digital offers the ability to exchange more complex information, better resistance to interference and better audio quality.

- Our new repeater will be delivered soon.
- In the mean-time the Club's 443.150 repeater has been taken out of service for repair.
- In its place, our repeater team has temporarily installed a digital repeater owned by WA1UTQ.
- When the new DR-2X repeater arrives and is installed, and our old .150 repeater is repaired, the old repeater will serve as a backup to the new repeater. PHEW!
