President's Report

- TVARC's next big event is Field Day, which will take place the weekend of June 24th & 25th, with some setup on June 23rd.
- I like to think of Field Day as an emergency preparedness exercise / demonstration.
 - Hundreds of clubs/groups/etc., get together and, starting from scratch, set up radios, erect antennas and make lots of contacts using emergency power.
 - Then, after 24 hours, they take it all down, pack it all up, and haul it away until next year.
- TVARC is blessed to be able to use the Sumter County Emergency Services trailer. It has:
 - A 30 foot crankup antenna tower
 - A huge generator
 - Air conditioning!

President's Report

- Preliminary plans for FD 2023 include utilizing the club's two Icom transceivers as SSB and CW stations, and to have a third station dedicated to GOTA (Get On The Air).
- The GOTA station is intended to provide an opportunity for newly licensed hams, or hams who have had their licenses for a while but haven't made any contacts yet, to make their initial on-the-air QSOs.

Partnering with CERT

- Recently, we announced a proposal to have TVARC members partner with CERT to augment CERT's emergency communications if and when the need arises.
- The proposal has been accepted, and we are now at the point where we would like to obtain about 10 volunteers from TVARC to sign up.
- During an emergency, volunteers will work under the direction of CERT, although it is not required to become a CERT member.
- When called out, volunteers will be assigned to a member of the Command Staff to act as their communications liaison.
- Training will be provided on relevant aspects of CERT.
